The Distinguished Club Award recognizes a Club's activity and productivity at every level of program involvement: Service, Programming, Membership, Leadership, Communication and the International Foundation. This Information will be used to judge whether a Club should receive a Distinguished Club Award.

PLEASE NOTE: The **Distinguished Club Award** application is separate from the Club Activity Report. The **Club Activity Report** is **NO** longer used to apply for the **Distinguished Club Award**.

- **Distinguished Club Award Applications** are submitted directly to the **Altrusa International Office** by **June 1st**.
- **Club Activity Reports** are submitted directly to the **District**.

Clubs that qualify for the Distinguished Club Award will receive a Banner Patch when the judging is completed and will be recognized in an Association publication and/or on its website.

Distinguished Club Criteria

1. Clubs are responsible for sending the new Distinguished Club Award application to the International Office for consideration to receive a Distinguished Club Award.
2. A Club must be at charter strength (20 members) to be considered for a Distinguished Club Award.
3. To be eligible, your Club must qualify for **at least 85 points** out of a possible total of 143-153 points from the following areas: Service, Programming, Membership, Leadership, Communication and the International Foundation.
